Human Subjects Protection Training

PURPOSE:

To identify staff required to complete human subjects protection training for the Multicenter Registry for Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy.

SCOPE:

All centers participating in the Multicenter Registry for Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy.

DEFINITIONS:

Human subjects protection training: Completion of Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI) program or local IRB-approved human-subjects training module. This training is also sometimes called Research Ethics and Compliance Training or Human Subject Research Training.

POLICY:

Ideally all staff should have completed research ethics and compliance training. Individuals who are only tasked with entering REDCap data and who are using the data as they would any other data at their center that is part of the medical record are not required to complete research ethics and compliance training. Individuals who are working with REDCap data for research purposes (i.e. developing posters, abstracts, or submission for publications) are required to complete research ethics and compliance training for human subjects.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Steering Committee representative at each center will ensure that staff have completed this training as required.
